

INTERNAL REGULATIONS

PREAMBLE - GENERAL CLAUSE

These regulations apply to all users of TRUCKS PARKING E42 and other sites belonging to MICADEL GROUP. TRUCKS PARKING E42 is a privately owned area. It is therefore subject to these operating regulations, which take precedence over any other document. By entering the parking area, all users of the parking facility (including vehicle owners and their employees) declare their full and unreserved acceptance of these operating regulations, which constitute a binding agreement without any possibility of modification except by express derogation granted by TRUCKS PARKING E42. In this regard, it is noted that all references to the Belgian Highway Code in these regulations have contractual value, and the parties expressly and unreservedly refer to them. All references to the Highway Code are understood to mean references to the provisions of the Belgian Highway Code in force and applicable on the date in question (the "Highway Code"). Any request for parking materialized by the entry of a Vehicle into the Parking lot automatically implies acceptance of these regulations and the immediate payment of the applicable rate or as provided for in a contract between the user and the Parking Operator.

[] PREAMBLE GENERAL CLAUSE These regulations apply to all users of TRUCKS PARKING E42 and other sites belonging to MICADEL GROUP. TRUCKS PARKING E42 is a privately owned area. It is therefore subject to these operating regulations, which take precedence over any other document. By entering the parking area, all users of the parking facility (including vehicle owners and their employees) declare their full and unreserved acceptance of these operating regulations, which constitute a binding agreement without any possibility of modification except by express derogation granted by TRUCKS PARKING E42. TITLE I – DEFINITION – DESCRIPTION

Article I-1:

Definitions I-1 – 1. Operator of the parking lot MICADEL GROUP srl, a private legal entity, owner and responsible for the management and operation of the Parking Lot (hereinafter the “Operator” or “TRUCKS PARKING E42”). I-1 – 2. Operations Staff The staff of TRUCKS PARKING E42 and that of its subcontractors, service providers or consultants, who ensure the management and operation of the site (hereinafter the “TRUCKS PARKING E42 Staff”). This includes in particular the sales, administrative, security and maintenance staff. I-1 – 3. Authorised Vehicle Refers to the vehicle authorised to enter the TRUCKS PARKING E42 and which can be categorized as heavy goods vehicles, namely a professional vehicle used for the transport of goods (hereinafter the “Vehicle”). I-1 – 4. User Refers to the driver of a Vehicle as well as any passenger.

TITLE II – CONDITIONS OF USE OF THE PARKING LOT

Article II-1: Vehicle Admission to the Parking Area. The parking area is

accessible every day, including Sundays and public holidays, to heavy goods vehicles. Entry to and use of the parking area is reserved for vehicles in roadworthy condition, in accordance with Belgian legislation and regulations and the traffic rules of the Highway Code as set forth in these regulations. Each vehicle admitted to the parking area must be insured. The driver is obligated to provide proof of this insurance upon the Operator's first request and, more generally, to comply with all legal and regulatory insurance obligations incumbent upon them. The driver of a vehicle must identify themselves upon entering the parking area. The same applies to any passengers. If there is more than one passenger per vehicle, the owner must notify TRUCKS PARKING E42 in advance and obtain their formal authorization before entering the parking area. These additional passengers are subject to the same identification requirement. TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff may deny access to vehicles whose entry could compromise the safety, durability, or proper operation of the facilities. Any vehicle whose user and/or owner has been flagged as a non-paying/disruptive customer during a previous visit to the parking lot, or based on any other information provided to TRUCKS PARKING E42, may be denied access. All vehicles parked in the parking lot must be kept in good working order, maintenance, and safety condition, particularly to allow for their removal in case of emergency. It is expressly forbidden to store in the Parking Area any product not listed on the Vehicle's transport document, and in particular any illegal, contaminating, toxic, explosive, or radioactive hazardous products (classes ARD 1, 6, and 7), and more generally any product, material, or item likely to damage or affect in any way the parking space made available, the Parking Area itself, as well as other Vehicles and products, materials, and goods stored by other Parking Area users. Any Vehicle entering the Parking Area requires a sworn statement from the User, whether the Vehicle owner or their representatives, attesting that: - The vehicle does not contain, and the user is not transporting, any narcotics whose use and transport are prohibited by the Belgian Penal Code, and - The vehicle does not contain any weapons, toxic products, explosives, or hazardous products whose use and possession are prohibited by applicable laws and regulations. The vehicle does not transport, whether in the cab, in the tractor or in the trailer, individuals in an irregular situation, that is to say without a valid residence permit, according to the applicable legislation. The Site Operator is exempt from all liability in this regard, particularly in the event of police or customs checks, such that no civil or criminal liability can be sought

against the Operator. Each User assumes the consequences of any breach of these regulations and agrees to fully compensate the Operator for the consequences of such breaches. All loading of a Vehicle must comply with Belgian police, security, and customs regulations.

Article II-2: Vehicle Entry and Exit to the Parking Area. Only one entry

method is currently permitted: by taking an entry ticket. The entry ticket indicates the transaction reference for entry to the parking area. The ticket and the numbers printed on it are strictly personal and confidential. There is no login code for the Wi-Fi service, which is free and covers the entire site. Any exchange of tickets between users is strictly prohibited, as is any reproduction of the ticket and any communication or disclosure of the numbers printed on it. The entry ticket is strictly personal and will allow the vehicle to exit the parking area by scanning its barcode. It will also allow users who have left the secure area on foot to re-enter it via the pedestrian turnstile. The parking facility includes three toll lanes, one of which is currently reserved for entry and one for exit. The third lane (the middle one) is a mixed (reversible) lane, and TRUCKS PARKING E42 reserves the right to allocate this third lane at any time to either the entry or exit of heavy goods vehicles, particularly to meet operational needs. All vehicle entry is via a gate with camera recording of the front of the vehicle, including the license plate. All vehicle exits are also via a gate. If payment has already been made (online via a booking website, at the central payment booth near the turnstile, or to the attendant), the barrier will open automatically thanks to the license plate recognition. If this is not the case, the driver also has the option of paying for parking directly in the exit vestibule by validating their entry ticket at the designated terminal, using one of the authorized payment methods. The entry and exit lanes are protected against forced exit by automatic barriers.

Article II-3: Parking Duration. Unless otherwise expressly agreed by

TRUCKS PARKING E42, the parking duration of a Vehicle may not exceed seven (7) days. Beyond this period, the Operator will be authorized to have the said Vehicle removed and impounded, without TRUCKS PARKING E42 being held liable in any way as a result. TRUCKS PARKING E42 reserves the right to recover by any means any sums that may be owed to it by the User and/or the Owner for the parking of the Vehicle in question, as well as all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the impoundment of said Vehicle.

Article II-4: Traffic within the Parking Area. Unless otherwise

indicated or stipulated in these regulations, the traffic laws of the Highway Code must be observed upon entering the parking area and apply throughout its premises. TRUCKS PARKING E42 shall not be held liable in any way, particularly in the event of damage to property or personal injury, for any failure by a Parking User to comply with these rules. Drivers of Vehicles must also comply with the orders and instructions of TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff and take, on their own initiative, the necessary measures to prevent accidents during maneuvers. The maximum speed of Vehicles within the parking area is set at 5 km/h.

Article II-5: Vehicle Movements within the Parking Area Vehicles are

only allowed to circulate within the Parking Area to enter or exit the premises.

Article II-6: Movements and maneuvers on order Parking agents must be

able, at any time, to require the owner of the Vehicle or, where applicable, the driver designated by him, to move the Vehicle or, failing that, be able to carry out the movement required by their own services, in case of extreme necessity and at the owner's expense and risk.

Article II-7: Emergency Measures TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff may, at any

time, require a vehicle user to perform any maneuver necessary for the safety of persons and/or property within the parking area. Furthermore, in the event of an emergency, which the Parking Operator deems appropriate, the right to intervene directly on the vehicle, including moving or removing it, and more generally, to take any necessary measures to address the emergency situation. The Parking Operator shall not be held liable for any damage caused to a vehicle during these operations. The Parking Operator may request reimbursement from the vehicle owner for all expenses incurred in the interest of the vehicle and/or compensation for any damage attributable to the abnormal situation of said vehicle.

Article II-8: Pedestrian Traffic The secure parking area is open only to

its users. Consequently, only pedestrians – drivers or passengers – are authorized to circulate within it to enter or exit their vehicles parked in the parking area. For this purpose, they must use the designated pedestrian walkways within the secure parking area. Pedestrians wishing to enter or exit the secure parking area must have their parking entry ticket and use either the pedestrian turnstile or, if applicable, the access gate connecting the secure parking area to the commercial building. Pedestrian traffic is strictly prohibited on internal roads and/or access and exit areas. Pedestrians are subject to the traffic regulations on public roads as set forth in the Highway Code.

Article II-9: Maintenance of Facilities Users of the Parking Facility

may not, under any circumstances, modify or damage the parking facility made available to them. They are responsible for any damage they cause to this facility. Users are required to report any damage they observe to the parking facility facilities made available to them without delay to TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff, whether caused by them or not. Repairs will be made at the expense of the person who caused the damage or the owner of the vehicle involved.

Article II-10: Parking Cleanliness Any deposit or abandonment of

equipment, products, or goods is prohibited within the parking area. In particular, it is forbidden to deposit soil, rubble, garbage, cigarette butts, unsanitary liquids, wastewater, or any other materials within the parking area, as well as to empty chemical toilets. Household waste must be deposited in the designated bins. Drivers of vehicles experiencing leaks related to their cargo or technical fluids are required to immediately inform TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff. They must take all necessary measures to limit the adverse effects of these leaks. Absorbent products are available at the security guard's counter. The management of this situation and its consequences is the sole responsibility of the driver of the defective vehicle and its owner.

Article II-11: Dangerous Goods In general, vehicles must not carry any

dangerous or explosive materials other than the fuels necessary for their operation. Access to the parking area is prohibited for vehicles classified as ADR classes 1, 6, and 7. However, access to the parking area for vehicles transporting dangerous goods of ADR/RTMD classes 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, and 9 will only be authorized with the express prior agreement of the parking operator. They will be parked in spaces designated by the security guard. A vehicle classified as ADR/RTMD parked in the parking area is prohibited from changing its location. The driver must provide the references and quantities of the products transported by any ADR/RTMD vehicle to TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff upon entering the parking area. This information will be compiled by TRUCKS PARKING E42 into a report that may, if necessary, be made available to the police, fire department, or civil protection services. This report will specify the number of ADR/RTMD vehicles parked, their locations, as well as the nature and quantity of their loads.

Article II-12: Restrictions on the Use of Fire To prevent any risk of

fire or explosion within the Parking area, smoking or having an open flame near flammable products and other hazardous materials without adequate ventilation is strictly prohibited. TRUCKS PARKING E42 reserves the right to prohibit smoking or the use of flame objects such as lighters or matches in all or part of the Parking area. In any case, the use of a barbecue or any other type of fire within the Parking area is strictly prohibited.

Article II-13: Refueling No refueling is permitted in the Parking Area

except for interventions necessary to remove a broken-down vehicle. It is forbidden to allow any oily, flammable, or corrosive liquids to spill in the Parking Area. Any spillage, including accidental spills, will be billed to the affected user or vehicle owner for the cost of cleaning and repairs, after the incident has been assessed by TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff.

Article II-14: Electrical Installations The electrical installations

located in the Parking Area are exclusively for lighting and/or reserved for TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff for the purposes of operating the Parking Area. The use of electrical outlets is prohibited for Parking Area

Users except in the cafeteria, restrooms, and bedrooms.

Article II-15: Restrictions on Use. The Operator reserves the right to

close the Parking facility at any time, including temporary, total, or partial closures, for maintenance or expansion work, for reasons of safety, hygiene, in the event of fire, weather or health events, or exceptional circumstances, or at the request of the authorities. No compensation arising from these specific circumstances, or more generally from the closure of the Parking facility, may be claimed from TRUCKS PARKING E42 due to the inability to use the Parking. The Parking facility may also be evacuated due to any danger, at the sole discretion of TRUCKS PARKING E42. In this case, the parking fee will remain due until the time of evacuation and may, if necessary, be collected during subsequent visits.

Article II-16: Fire Safety Instructions In the event of a fire within

the Parking area or in adjacent areas, all Users, including Vehicle owners and/or drivers and any passengers, must take the precautionary measures prescribed by TRUCKS PARKING E42 Staff. In the event of a fire on board a Vehicle, the owner, driver, or passengers of said Vehicle must immediately notify TRUCKS PARKING E42 Staff and the fire department (tel: 112), who may request assistance from other Parking users.

Article II-17: Audible Alarms An alarm siren is installed to warn of any

danger within the parking area. A prevention plan is posted at the parking entrance. If the alarm siren is triggered, drivers must immediately go to the assembly point located near the entrance and follow the instructions given by TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff and/or the fire department. In the event of repeated and untimely activation of automatic audible alarms on a vehicle, TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff reserve the right to intervene to disable the devices by any means necessary, without TRUCKS PARKING E42 being held liable in any way for such actions.

Article II-18: Vehicle Parking Vehicle parking within the parking area

is strictly limited to designated spaces. A vehicle must be parked in such a way that it does not encroach on the traffic lane, the adjacent space(s), or cross the boundaries between spaces. When a vehicle is parked in the parking area, the driver must switch off the engine immediately upon completion of the parking maneuver and, upon departure, limit the engine's idle time to the time strictly necessary for starting. Maneuvering or driving a vehicle belonging to another user, as well as using any parking equipment or facilities, is expressly prohibited. Signage is in place indicating parking areas and vehicle traffic zones. The Operator shall under no circumstances be held liable, and shall not incur any responsibility arising from thefts, offenses, damage, or accidents caused to third parties (including other Users) or to other Vehicles, whether parked in authorized or unauthorized spaces. The User is required to immediately report to TRUCKS PARKING E42 Staff any accidents, damage, or vandalism they cause

involving the Parking facilities, TRUCKS PARKING E42 Staff, other Parking Users, and/or other Vehicles parked in the Parking area.

Article II-19: Good Neighborliness Obligations The rules of good

neighborliness apply within the Parking Area. TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff and users are required to be courteous in their interactions. It is forbidden to carry out any work on vehicles that could cause a nuisance to the neighborhood, and in particular to other Parking Area users. Users are prohibited from taking photographs or filming within the Parking Area without the prior express authorization of TRUCKS PARKING E42.

Article II-20: Fees Occupying a parking space incurs a fee. The amount

of this fee, whether annual, monthly, daily, or hourly, is determined based on the vehicle's parking duration (see current rates). Fee amounts are communicated to Users by posting at the parking entrance and/or at the monitoring station and/or on the TRUCKS PARKING E42 website. Payment of the fee must be made by any means authorized by TRUCKS PARKING E42 at the time it is due. The collection of the fee is recorded in the Operator's accounts and a receipt may be issued upon request by the User. No vehicle may leave the parking lot until the fee payable by the User has been paid in full. In the event that automatic payment methods are unavailable or if a vehicle user is unable to pay the required fee, TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff will be required to present the driver's identification and the vehicle registration documents (V5C). In any case, TRUCKS PARKING E42 reserves the right to refuse entry to any vehicle that has not paid the required fee.

Article II-21: Loss or Invalidity of the Entry Ticket and/or

Identification Number. In the event of loss or invalidity of the entry ticket and/or identification number issued upon entry to the Parking facility, the User must present the Vehicle registration document and proof of identity. TRUCKS PARKING E42 will verify the date and time of the Vehicle's entry and may, following these verifications, issue a new ticket or number necessary for payment of the fee and for the Vehicle's exit. In any event, TRUCKS PARKING E42 cannot be held liable for any difficulties and consequences, including financial ones, resulting from the loss of the entry ticket or identification number by a User.

Article II-22: Parking Security The parking lot is enclosed and

monitored by video cameras. A human presence is ensured 24/7 by TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff (TRUCKS PARKING E42 security guard or one of its service providers). Random patrols may be carried out at any time of day or night, including Sundays and public holidays. Video cameras also record pedestrian entry and exit, as well as vehicle lanes. Video recordings are kept for 30 days (unless requested by the police).

Article II-23: Uncoupling and Recoupling of Trailers No uncoupling or

recoupling of trailers is permitted in the Parking Area. However, after notification to the TRUCKS PARKING E42 representative present on site, these maneuvers may be authorized under the following conditions, in designated areas indicated to Users by TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff: 1 – Uncoupling The driver uncoupling a trailer must present documents that identify their tractor and trailer and verify their identity. They must also provide the identification of the driver and tractor who will be retrieving the trailer if they are different. 2 – Recoupling The driver recoupling a trailer must present documents that identify their tractor and trailer and verify their identity. These documents must match the identification information provided by the driver who uncoupled the trailer. Any official document may be requested from the driver recoupling the trailer to verify their legitimacy. TRUCKS PARKING E42 reserves the right to block the trailer and its recoupling if any doubt remains between the identification declared when the trailer was uncoupled and the actual identification of the driver or the tractor unit responsible for recoupling the trailer. TRUCKS PARKING E42 cannot be held liable for any accident or damage of any kind occurring during the uncoupling or recoupling of a trailer within the parking area. In particular, TRUCKS PARKING E42 cannot be held liable in the absence of a driver declaration or in the event of fraud, false declaration, or misleading or deceptive statements. Upon request from the owners of the tractor unit and/or trailer in question, TRUCKS PARKING E42 may provide a copy of the documents presented and the declarations made during the uncoupling and/or recoupling of the trailer. A fee may be charged by TRUCKS PARKING E42 for this service; its amount is displayed at the entrance to the parking lot.

Article II-24: WIFI The Parking Facility provides a WIFI connection to

Users under the conditions set forth below, which specify, in particular, the responsibilities of the users, in accordance with the law and to ensure normal and optimal use of this service. Each User is legally responsible for their use of this WIFI connection, and TRUCKS PARKING E42 cannot be held liable in any way for such use. The User is informed that the internet is a network that carries data that may be protected by intellectual, literary, or artistic property rights, or that may infringe upon applicable legal provisions. The User is therefore prohibited from transmitting any prohibited, illicit, illegal, immoral, or public order data over the internet, or data that infringes or is likely to infringe upon the rights of third parties, and in particular intellectual, literary, or artistic property rights. In particular, the User is prohibited from committing offenses and acts of piracy that infringe upon the rights of others and the safety of individuals. The User agrees not to intentionally perform any actions that could result in concealing their true identity, appropriating another User's password, altering or modifying data or accessing information belonging to other network users, interrupting or disrupting the normal operation of the network or any systems connected to the network, modifying or destroying information on any system, or connecting or attempting to connect to a website without authorization. The User also agrees not to engage in any illegal, fraudulent, abusive, or excessive use of the Wi-Fi service, such as, in particular, accessing websites that are racist, pedophilic, or incite hatred or violence, or sending unsolicited messages, including offensive, defamatory, obscene, indecent, illegal, or otherwise infringing content, particularly human rights and the protection of minors, and more generally, any act of spamming. Regarding products or services on the internet, the User must address any complaints relating to the performance of services rendered or the sale of products by the content providers directly to them. The User is solely responsible for any direct or

indirect, tangible or intangible damage caused to third parties as a result of their own use of the Wi-Fi connection provided by TRUCKS PARKING E42.

Article II-25: Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages or Narcotics Access to

the Parking Area is strictly prohibited to any User under the influence of alcohol or narcotics. It is strictly forbidden for any User to consume narcotics or be intoxicated within the Parking Area. In the event of non-compliance with this article, TRUCKS PARKING E42 reserves the right to immediately revoke the parking permit granted to the User's Vehicle and, if necessary, to have the Vehicle removed at the expense of both the User and the Vehicle owner. TRUCKS PARKING E42 may also contact the appropriate police services.

TITLE III – POLICE PROVISIONS ARTICLE III-1: TRAFFIC RULES THE FOLLOWING

traffic rules must be observed at all times within the Parking Area: - - - Every vehicle must ensure, before any movement, that no pedestrian is in its path. Any vehicle following another vehicle maneuvering to park must yield to the latter. Users preparing to exit a parking space must ensure that their maneuver does not pose any danger to vehicles and pedestrians moving on the traffic lanes, to whom they must yield the right-of-way. - At any intersection or meeting of two or more traffic lanes, vehicles must yield to those coming from their right, unless otherwise indicated by a special sign or express signal from a parking attendant. - - - - The maximum speed of vehicles on the traffic lanes is 5 km/h. Overtaking is prohibited. Reversing is only permitted when maneuvering into or out of a parking area. Parking is prohibited outside designated parking areas, including on access lanes. In addition, the traffic rules of the Highway Code apply within the parking area.

Article III-2: Hazardous Products The introduction of combustible,

explosive, or flammable materials (other than the normal contents of their vehicle's fuel tank) into the Parking area by users is strictly prohibited. To prevent any risk of fire or explosion within the Parking area, smoking or the use of any flame-producing object near flammable products or other hazardous materials without adequate ventilation is strictly prohibited.

Article III-3: Soliciting and Advertising Any soliciting, sale of any

item whatsoever, or offer of service, whether free of charge or not, is strictly prohibited within the Parking area and the service building. The same applies to any peddling, canvassing, unpacking, advertising, posting, and distribution of leaflets.

Article III-4: Animals N/A

Article III-5: Monthly Parking When a Vehicle is parked for more than

one month with the express authorization of the Operator, the user will be required to pay the monthly fee due for that period in advance. Failing this, the Operator will be authorized to have the Vehicle removed and impounded, without TRUCKS PARKING E42 being held liable in any way. TRUCKS PARKING E42 reserves the right to recover, by any means, at the expense of the User or the Vehicle owner, the sums due for the parking of the Vehicle in question, as well as all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the impoundment of said Vehicle.

Article III-6: Prohibition of two-wheeled vehicle traffic For safety

reasons, apart from a service vehicle, no two-wheeled vehicle is allowed to circulate in the Parking lot, except with prior and express authorization from TRUCKS PARKING E42.

Article III-7: Reporting of offences Any offence against the preceding

provisions shall be recorded in a daily log or shall be the subject of a report drawn up by a member of the TRUCKS PARKING E42 Staff, independently of any civil or judicial proceedings to which the offence may give rise under applicable legislation and regulations, and in particular under the Belgian Penal Code.

TITLE IV – MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Article IV-1: Liability. Parking Users move and park in the Parking

facility at their own risk, particularly with regard to damage of any kind or theft to their Vehicles, their contents, or themselves within the Parking facility. Each User is responsible for any accidents and damage of any kind that they may cause to other Parking Users, their Vehicles and other property, as well as to TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff and the Parking facility's facilities. The Operator provides general surveillance of the Parking facility. Under no circumstances can the Operator be considered the custodian or guardian of a Vehicle and its contents. The Operator is not liable and cannot be held responsible for any accidents, thefts, assaults, damage, or harm of any kind caused to Vehicles, their contents, and Parking Users by third parties (including other Users) or by external events, including inclement weather. In particular, the Operator is not liable for any damages resulting from acts of vandalism committed within the Parking facility. Nor is the Operator liable for any thefts that may occur within the Parking facility, whether concerning users or their Vehicles, their accessories, goods, contents, or other items and valuables left inside or in trunks, trailers, or secured outside the Vehicles. Any accident or damage of any kind must be reported immediately to TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff and to the insurance companies of the user concerned.

INTERNAL REGULATIONS

Article IV-2: Complaints Register A register, countersigned by the

Operator, will be kept in the TRUCKS PARKING E42 control room located at the entrance to the parking lot. This register will be used to record complaints or observations from individuals who may have grievances against the Operator or its staff. The register will be numbered and initialed by a representative of the Parking Operator.

Article IV-3: Enforcement of Violations of these Regulations In the

event of non-compliance with any provision of these regulations, TRUCKS PARKING E42 staff will take all necessary measures to stop the violation. Failure to comply with any of the obligations contained in these regulations may lead the Operator to withdraw the parking authorization granted to the Vehicle. The Operator reserves the right to expel any offender, at the offender's expense and risk, if necessary by resorting to law enforcement. In the event of withdrawal of this authorization, the entire fee already paid or owed by the User or the Vehicle owner, regardless of the expiry date of the period in question, will remain due or payable, as applicable, to the Operator. The Operator also reserves the right to file a complaint and claim damages from any offender of these regulations.

Article IV-4: Processing and Protection of Personal Data. TRUCKS PARKING

E42 attaches great importance to respecting the privacy of its customers and users and to protecting their personal data. TRUCKS PARKING E42 undertakes to ensure that personal data is processed in accordance with the applicable legal and regulatory provisions, in particular the [relevant legislation/law] in its current version, as well as the European General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") No. 2016/679 of April 27, 2016 (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Regulations"). TRUCKS PARKING E42 is indeed required, in the course of its activities, to collect and process Personal Data (as defined below) concerning its customers and users. TRUCKS PARKING E42 explains below why, as the Data Controller (as defined below), it needs to collect Personal Data, how this data is used and protected, how long it is kept, and the rights individuals have to control it.

1. Definitions

- Personal Data: refers to any information that directly or indirectly identifies or makes identifiable a natural person. For example: name and surname, photograph, driver's license, etc.
- Data Subject: refers to the natural person whose Personal Data is collected and processed by TRUCKS PARKING E42 or one of its Subcontractors (as defined below), such as, in particular, customers or users of the Parking facility.
- Processing: refers to any operation or set of operations performed on personal data, whether or not by automated means, on electronic or paper media, such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, or dissemination.
- Data Controller: refers to the natural or legal person, public authority, agency, or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing.
- Data Processor: refers to any person outside TRUCKS PARKING E42 who performs any activity on behalf of TRUCKS PARKING E42 and who has access, in any form whatsoever, to personal data.

2. What information does TRUCKS PARKING E42 hold about Data Subjects and why? TRUCKS PARKING E42 processes personal data only if such processing is justified and complies with applicable regulations. Therefore, it collects the Personal Data of the Data

Subjects only if necessary and relevant: • If it has obtained the prior consent of the Data Subjects; • Or if the processing is necessary for compliance with its legal or regulatory obligations; • Or if the processing is necessary to protect the vital interests of the Data Subjects; • Or if the processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Data Subjects and does not unduly affect the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the Data Subjects. Thus, as mentioned in these operating regulations, TRUCKS PARKING E42 may collect and process the following Personal Data: - Photos and videos for managing safety, security of people and property, and logistical needs via its video surveillance and access control systems; Name, surname, nationality, copy of an identity document (identity card, passport, visa, etc.), driver's license, vehicle registration document, green card (international motor insurance card), for managing subscriptions, collecting fees, or handling complaints when users or customers contact TRUCKS PARKING E42 (by any means of communication) or when they report a problem via the complaints and observations registers. Furthermore, the parking facility is equipped with a license plate recognition system to control and facilitate vehicle access, entry, and exit, and to provide proof of parking duration in case of a lost customer or user ticket. Only the license plate (which can be traced back to the vehicle owner) and the lower part of the front of the vehicle are photographed by the device, but under no circumstances are the driver or passengers photographed.

3. Who has access to Personal Data and to whom is it transferred? Access to Personal Data is strictly limited to those authorized by TRUCKS PARKING E42, including its staff, service providers, and subcontractors, particularly those responsible for the management, upkeep, and maintenance of the devices or, more generally, the parking facility. The third parties mentioned above have only limited access to the Personal Data that TRUCKS PARKING E42 transmits to them and are obligated to process it in strict compliance with applicable regulations and, where applicable, in accordance with their contractual obligations. Some of this Personal Data may be disclosed, upon request, to judicial authorities, tax authorities, debt collection agencies, or any law enforcement body, court, regulator, government authority, or other third party if necessary to comply with a legal or regulatory obligation. The recipients of the Personal Data (whether for hosting purposes or for the transfer of Personal Data itself) are located within the European Union. The communication of Personal Data therefore does not involve transfers of information outside the European Union. In cases where such a transfer of Personal Data would occur outside the European Union, TRUCKS PARKING E42 undertakes to implement appropriate measures to ensure a sufficient level of protection.

4. How does TRUCKS PARKING E42 protect Personal Data? Personal Data is stored in the databases of TRUCKS PARKING E42 and, where applicable, those of its parent company, MICADEL GROUP SRL, or in the databases of their subcontractors or service providers. Throughout the entire retention period of this Personal Data, TRUCKS PARKING E42 and, where applicable, MICADEL GROUP SRL, implement all appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure its confidentiality and protection, and thus guarantee a level of security appropriate to the risk. They therefore take all necessary measures to prevent, in particular, the risks of destruction, loss, alteration, disclosure, reproduction, or unauthorized access, and require their subcontractors and service providers to implement appropriate measures.

5. How long does TRUCKS PARKING E42 retain Personal Data? The Personal Data of Data Subjects is retained for limited periods of time (for example, video recordings are kept for 30 days) and, in any event, for periods necessary and proportionate to the purposes for which it was collected, and also to comply with legal requirements aimed at prosecuting criminal offenses.

6. What are the rights of Data Subjects and how can they be exercised? In accordance with applicable regulations, data subjects have the following rights: • Access to all their data • Rectification in the event of inaccurate or incomplete information • Erasure or portability of their data • Restriction or objection to their processing for legitimate

reasons, where applicable, and the right to withdraw their consent. Article IV-5:

Publicity - Enforceability Entering the Parking, Requesting or using the facilities implies that each User is aware of these regulations and agrees to abide by them. The regulations will be available (upon request) at all times at the parking lot ticket office in paper format, via a QR code at the parking lot ticket office within the building, and on the TRUCKS PARKING E42 website.

Article IV-6: Jurisdiction for the

enforcement of these regulations. Any dispute relating to the enforcement or interpretation of these regulations shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of Charleroi, notwithstanding multiple parties or third-party claims. These regulations are governed by Belgian law.

- **MAXIMUM SPEED: 5 km/h** within the parking premises
- **NO SMOKING** near flammable products
- **BARBECUES AND OPEN FIRES** strictly forbidden
- **EMPTYING CHEMICAL TOILETS** forbidden
- **ADR CLASS 1, 6 and 7 VEHICLES** forbidden
- **MAXIMUM PARKING DURATION: 7 days** (unless authorized)
- **24/7 SURVEILLANCE** by video and human presence
